## **ODTCW COVID-19 GUIDELINES**

The ODTCW Board has instituted the following guidelines to ensure the safety of our members, students, instructors and everyone who enters our building. **During club sponsored events that bring a group of people together (run-thru's, trials, etc.) additional procedures may be implemented.** 

These procedures follow all state mandated pandemic guidelines and must be strictly adhered to. Anyone not following these guidelines may be removed from the property by the ODTCW representative on site.

If you have tested positive for COVID-19 you may not use the building or participate in any club activity until you have received a negative test.

Do not enter the building if you are experiencing any COVID 19 symptoms. If you have been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or if you have traveled outside the US or visited any of the currently restricted states do not enter the building for at least 14 days.

When inside the building or outside on club property, a minimum 6' distance must be maintained or a MASK IS REQUIRED.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 7NNN, masks or cloth face coverings that cover a person's nose and mouth are required to be worn when in public and a six-foot distance is unavoidable, whether indoors or outdoors.

Remember that not everyone has the same level of comfort regarding the use of masks even if the 6' distance is maintained. Everyone has the right to feel safe without fear of criticism or ridicule. While on club property, if you are asked to step further away or to wear a mask you must do so.

Two automatic hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed, one near the front door and one near the thermostat. Use hand sanitizer prior to touching any club equipment and wash your hands frequently.

Our facility is cleaned once per week using appropriate sanitizing cleansers. In order to limit cross contamination, everyone is encouraged to bring their own sanitizing spray and/or wipes to disinfect any club equipment they use including door handles.

Class sizes are limited and only one handler per dog will be allowed unless approved in advance by the instructor.
